Other than the few country members in the club NO BENCHING WILL BE CONDUCTED ON SUN-DAY. A country member is determined to be a member who lives outside 100km of the CBD.

PHOTOS must be brought on Saturday to allow correct benching. Both sets will be retained by the benching team. One set goes to the judging team, the second set will be returned to the individual member on Sunday morning.
